

## **University Curriculum Committee**

## **Committee Charges**

Approved March 14, 2000

The domain of this committee involves the policies, procedures, programmatic offerings and curricular issues of the university. The goal of this committee is to help deliver the highest quality curriculum across the university that is consistent with the mission of the university, the social and economic demographics of the region, and institutional resource and budgetary issues.

## **Standing Charges:**

- 1. To routinely consider program documents reflective of curricula across the university and make recommendations regarding their approval to the University Senate in a timely fashion.
- 2. To maintain a broad institutional perspective in reviewing and evaluating programmatic proposals.
- **3.** To make curricular policy recommendations consistent with the university's mission, the region's social and economic demographics and issues of budgetary and institutional resources.
- **4.** To review overall curriculum procedures and make policy recommendations to the University Senate.
- 5. To serve as arbiter in matters of curricular conflict between colleges.
- **6.** To review specific curricula and programs which appear to deviate from approved goals or established standards.
- 7. To periodically review and recommend revising the Curriculum Procedures Document to the University Senate.
- **8.** To fulfill any specific or special charges from the University Senate.
- **9.** To make periodic reports, a mid-year progress report, and issue a final report to the University Senate at the end of the Academic Year.
